Dartmouth House, on Charles Street off Berkeley Square, was constructed in the 18th-century, and was converted by Lord Revelstoke into a beautiful Mayfair town house in the later 19th-century. Today Dartmouth House stands as the home of the English-Speaking Union.

Many stunning original features are preserved, from the Robert Adam fireplace to the painted ceiling by Pierre-Victor Galland above the grand Belgian marble staircase leading to the 1st floor event spaces.

Dartmouth House boasts one of London's rarest and most endearing features – an enclosed courtyard for hosting open-air receptions. The fountain, architectural style and wrought iron tables and chairs combine to create the atmosphere of a chateau terrace.
